Avoid micromanaging remote teams—delegate clearly, set goals, trust their abilities, and empower decision-making and growth opportunities.



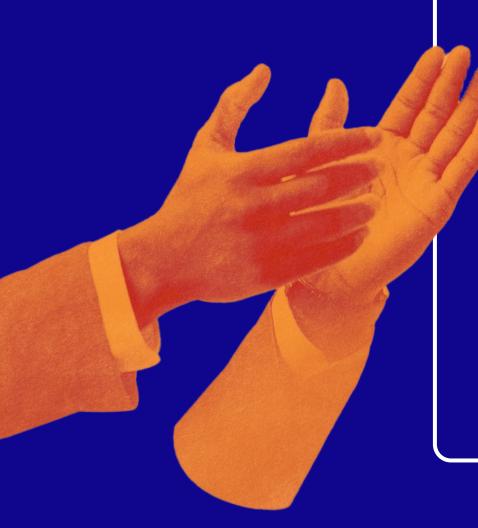


3. Establish a Strong Company Culture:

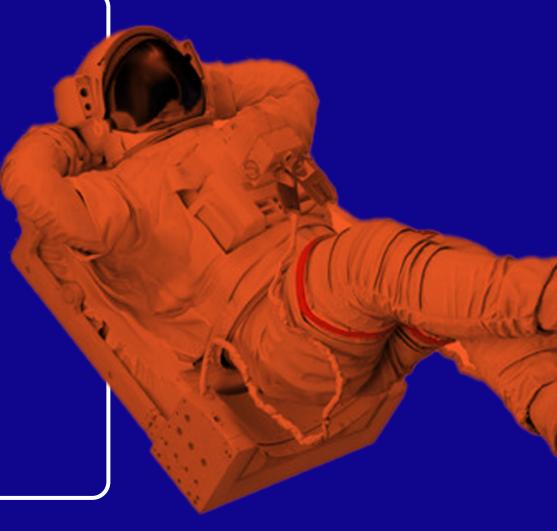


4. Set Boundaries and Respect Work-Life Balance:
